2010 - 2011 SCHOOL SUPPLY LISTS

THIRD GRADE

- 2 pkgs. 300 count WIDE-LINED loose leaf paper
- 1 pink pearl eraser
- 1 lg. pkg. pencil toppers
- 3 boxes of tissue
- 1 pair 6 inch (or longer) scissors
- 1 bottle of white glue
- 4 folders with brads
- 1 box of crayons – 24 count
- 1 set of colored pencils – 12 count or more
- 2 glue stick
- 1 pkg. wide basic colored markers (washable)
- 3 spiral notebooks
- Pencils 24 pkg. each nine weeks
- 1 individual pencil sharpener (no battery operated sharpeners)
- 1 pkg. of 2 dry erase markers – black Wide chisel
- Small 3 ring binder (1 inch rings)
- 1 container of Clorox wipes (boys)
- 1 container of baby wipes (girls)
- 1 small book bag or backpack (no wheels or rollers)

FOURTH GRADE

- 1 box of 24 count crayons
- Pencils as needed
- 3 boxes of tissue
- 2 pkgs. of 150 count WIDE-LINED loose leaf paper
- 1 pkg. of pencil top erasers
- 3 blue and 3 green spiral notebooks – about 70 sheets of wide ruled paper
- 3 blue and 3 green folders with brads
- 2 pack of glue sticks
- 1 pkg. of markers (boys)
- 1 pkg. of freezer bags, quart size(boys)
- 1 pkg. of colored pencils (girls)
- 1 container of Clorox wipes (girls)
- 4 Expo dry erase markers
- 4 pocket folders with brads (assorted colors)
- 1 book bag or backpack (no wheels or rollers)

FIFTH GRADE

- Large 3 ring binder. Prefer 2 inch rings
- 6 subject dividers with pockets
- 2 pkgs. WIDE-LINED loose leaf paper
- Wooden pencils or mechanical pencils and lead – as needed
- 2 pkgs. pencil topper erasers
- Ruler (marked in inches and centimeters) – wooden
- Scissors
- 3 boxes of tissue
- 1 pkg. of colored pencils – 12 pack
- 5 pocket folders with brads (plain colors: red, blue, green, yellow, orange)
- Pencil bag (to fit in 3 ring binder)
- 5 single subject spirals (wide ruled) (Plain-no designs: blue, green, yellow, 2 red)
- Dry erase markers (black – fine tip) 4 pack
- 2 pkg. red pens (10-12 per pack)
- 1 book bag or backpack (no wheels or rollers)

Teachers may have additional supply lists in their classrooms.

Amounts are estimates. Students are responsible for having pencil and paper in class each day.
